Everyone was proud to witness the many Awards which were presented to them in recognition of their extraordinary contributions to Reach Society and our young people.

Two further high points of this enjoyable evening were the naming of Professor Trevor Williams, University of Derby, & Chief Economist, Lloyds Bank Wholesale Markets, as the newest patron for Reach Society; and the presentation by Jeremy Adam, Lloyds Banking Group, of the Community Fund winner's certificate for London southwest to Reach Society.

Several professionals were honoured with Supporter of Reach Society Awards for their unselfish work on 11 April 2012 for reaching back to encourage, motivate and inspire some 400 young people, and their parents, at the first Careers Conference, held at HMS President (the building).

Two exceptional professionals, Grantley Yearwood and Robert Neil, were honoured with Fellows of Reach Society Awards for their sustained meritorious contributions to Reach Society. In fact Robert was one of the co-founders of the Society, and Grantley was a member of the management committee, where he served as the first programme director for the outreach work with young people.
