Milestone Recognition Awards Celebration 2015

Demani Jules-Carbon, a UCFB undergraduate, was honoured for winning the UCFB Reach Society full scholarship (worth £27,000 over 3 years); and Ms Koral O.P. Neil, an actress, won the ICE Books Reader Award, becoming the second recipient, at the 2015 Milestone Recognition Awards.

In October roughly 135 guests, dressed in black tie and ball gowns, turned out from the Black community to honour the largest cohort of sixty professional men and women from a range of disciplines.

Everyone was proud to network with them and witness the many Awards they received in recognition of their extraordinary contributions to Reach Society and our young people. Guests were also delighted to celebrate the Society's milestone of five years serving the community by inspiring no fewer than 4,000 young people.

The guests also heard the inspirational and thought provoking welcome address from the Society's patron Lord Herman Ouseley and the talk from the extraordinary guest speaker Courtenay Griffiths, QC, who paid tribute to the spirit of self-help within the Society, and the key role confidence plays in the development of our young people.

Each of the guest presenters John Budu-Aggrey, from Alpha BSE Training, Dr Patrick Marshall, from Birmingham University, Daniel Norris, from City & Islington College, Dr Roxanne Ferdinand, from Pfizer and Richard Cooper, from Lloyds Banking Group, also paid tribute to the many award winners for their compassion.

On the night several professionals, slightly fewer than two dozen, were honoured with Supporter of Reach Society Awards for their unselfish work on 9 April 2015 for reaching back to encourage, motivate and inspire roughly 750 young people, and their parents, at the 4th Careers Conference at the Methodist Central Hall, Westminster. And three professionals won the prestigious Fellow of Reach Society Awards.

Leon Neil, Rolston Dennis and Ritchie Neil picked up Fellows of Reach Society Awards for their sustained meritorious contributions to Reach Society. All have served the Society since the Careers Conferences were launched.
