2019 Recognition Awards Report

On Saturday, 19 October, in Kensington a capacity audience of roughly 200 guests attended Reach Society's 8th Recognition Awards dinner. This annual event in the Black community once again attracted guests from places outside of London such as Kent, Leicester and Birmingham. Guests heard about the Glasgow University plaque for commemorating the people who suffered enslavement which was unveiled by Professor Sir Geoff Palmer; the impact of the Society's collaboration with Durham University that is set to transform the lives of a group of Black students who impressed during their SP summer school; and they heard a tribute to Rolston Dennis who passed suddenly last November.

The Society's Patron, Professor Sir Geoff Palmer opened proceedings by welcoming everyone to the Recognition Awards evening; and he talked about the plaque that commemorates all those who suffered trans-Atlantic enslavement. **Nasif Mugisha** picked up the first **Rolston Dennis ICE Books Reader's Award** from John Budu-Aggrey, director, Alpha BSE Training. As a tribute to the Society's former team member this award now includes his name. **Solomon Akinmoluwa** won the inaugural **Alpha City & Guild Scholarship**, which funds a diploma in electronics and sets him on his way to self-employment. It was presented by Lily Sun, director, Alpha BSE Training.

Brian Mitchell, the chief operations officer in Grace Foods UK presented the 2019 Scholarship Trophy to **Alex King**, who became the third recipient of the **Grace Foods and Reach Society Scholarship**. He is the latest British young man of Caribbean background to win this scholarship for study at Brunel University London from September this year. The scholarship package covers the funds needed to pay all tuition fees for his first degree; it provides a paid internship during a summer break; and access to the university's mentoring programme.

In his address Professor Alan Houston, Vice-Provost Education, Durham University highlighted the importance of high value universities doing more to attract undergraduates from the Black community, and he expressed a strong desire to build on the good work currently underway with Reach Society.

In his address Martin P. Griffiths DL, Consultant Trauma Surgeon in the NHS talked about his diverse responsibilities as a lead trauma surgeon, clinical director for violence reduction and as a new Deputy Lieutenant in Greater London. He also shared that everyone can help to make a better and safer community.

This year four **Champion Supporter Awards** were presented to Marva Rollins OBE, Paula Neil, Winston Bygrave, and Ritchie Neil. Each was outstanding in different ways. Marva has been a constant promoter of the Society over many years and a regular volunteer at large events. Paula has co-authored all of the Society's 4 books and is a longstanding volunteer at events across the UK. Winston has been a role model for several years and has hosted several of the Society's training sessions in his church. And Ritchie has been a role model over several years in events across London and across the country.

Five employers - Alpha BSE Training, Brunel University London, High Speed 2, Network Rail, and the Royal Air Force - received the **Corporate Champion of Reach Society Awards** for their contributions as outstanding collaboration partners. Alpha

In addition, 11 outstanding professionals picked up the **RAF Fellows Awards.** They were: Angela Clarke, Demani Jules-Carbon, Giles Speid, Howard Bowen, Kenaz Moore, Sonia Palmer, Leon Neil, Martin P. Griffiths DL, Peter Denis, Professor Clive Fraser and Rianne Palmer.

Corporate Supporter Awards were picked up by 7 employers: Amos Bursary, Deloitte LLP, Glasgow University, Imperial College London, Kilburn & Strode LLP, Lloyds Banking Group and Zurich Commercial Insurance - two of whom were first timer winners.

In addition, 7 corporates picked up **Corporate Fellow of Reach Society Awards** for their exemplary commitment to the work the Society is doing to inspire young people. They were Durham University, Enfield Caribbean Association, King's College London, London Black Teachers' Network, Metropolitan Police Service, RAFFA and V Jay Theatre Productions.
